4	Maker’s stamp – wooden handle – very good condition	140mm x 40mm	Wooden Handled maker’s stamp of “CHANOT” in approx. 8pt; Some annotation on handle
5	Small metal maker’s stamp – very good condition	70mm x 20mm x 5mm	Metal maker’s stamp of “W ^m A. CHANOT” in approx. 8pt
6	Metal maker’s stamp – very good condition	85mm x 25mm x 10mm	Metal maker’s stamp of “JOSEPH A. CHANOT” in approx. 8pt
7	Circular plaster figure head – fair condition	180mm diameter	Plaster figure head – circular – of “G Chanot” – dated 1852 by “L Lolary”; has been broken and repaired
8	Adjustable dividers – W&D Ltd – fair condition	260mmx35mmx30mm	Adjustable dividers – multi-pointed. Annotations on brass – CIRCLES, RATIOS, PLANS, SOLIDS. Made by W&D Ltd.
9	Boxed set Architecture	570mm x 100mm x	Boxed set (incomplete) of

	Drawing Curves by Hudelo of Paris	160mm	drawing curves – each stamped with external diameter in “inches” and makers name – Hudelo a Paris – 10-11 (no maker mark), 13-14, 16-40, 42, 44-46, 47 (damaged) 48-50, 52, 54, 56, 58, 60, 62, 64 (damaged), 74 (damaged) 76
10	Rib Bending Iron (Cast Iron)	Part 1: Part 2: 460mm x 70mm x 30mm	Black two-piece rib/wood bending iron. Part 1: heating element – heated on an open fire – bulb head with square handle; Part 2: outer sleeve for bending around.
11	Violin Carrying Case (Poor condition)	620mm x 230mm x 85mm	Wooded violin carrying case – originally lined and having a keyed locking mechanism – now with simple hook and eye closure.
